

Instructions for submitting an Extended Abstract

Potential authors are invited to submit an extended abstract in English in all areas of **Robotics and Intelligent Machines**, along with an optional video. Innovative contributions, position papers and preliminary results will be accepted, provided their originality is well contextualized.

The recommended length is **2 A4 pages**, but submissions of up to 4 pages are accepted with additional payment. Accepted contributions will be collected in the digital **conference proceedings**, along with any videos. They will be freely accessible (Open Access Gold), digitally indexed (DOI) and citable.

Instructions

- 1. Prepare an extended abstract of the work in English, with a length of 2 A4 pages, formatted in double column. Word and LaTeX templates (in IEEE format) are available, which include instructions for their use. Generate a PDF file for submission. Contributions should present innovative results, including recently published work, in all areas of robotics and intelligent machines. The goal is to showcase the main scientific, industrial, and application-oriented activities carried out in the field, highlighting research results and placing particular emphasis on new perspectives and opportunities for our country.
- 2. The extended abstract may be accompanied by an illustrative video of maximum 2 minutes in duration, in one of the following formats: .mp4, .mpg, .wmv, .mov, or .avi. The maximum file **size is 20MB**. It is recommended to use standard codecs to ensure portability. Commercial content should be avoided.
- 3. Access the **EasyChair website** associated with the conference. If you do not already have an EasyChair account, click on "create an account" to register, enter the required information, and then resume the procedure.
- 4. Select the option "**IRIM-3D 2025**" on the first screen or connect directly to: https://easychair.org/conferences/?conf=irim3d2025
- 5. Enter the information for all authors, including email address and affiliation (both are required). Indicate the **corresponding author(s)** usually only one.
- 6. Enter the **title** of the work, a brief **abstract** (maximum 500 characters), and at least **three keywords**, one per line.
- 7. Select at least one of the following **topics**: Hostile and unstructured environments, Inspection and maintenance of infrastructures, Healthcare and wellness of persons, Industry 4.0, Agrifood, Mobility and autonomous vehicles
- 8. Answer "no" to the question: "Are you submitting a workshop proposal?"
- 9. Upload the **Extended Abstract** and optionally the **Video Clip**, then click **Submit**.
- 10. All authors will receive a **confirmation email** upon successful submission.
- 11. It is possible to **modify the data and uploaded files** by reconnecting to the website until the **submission deadline**.

Submitted materials will be evaluated by the Program Committee. Notification of acceptance will be sent to the corresponding authors by the specified date.
